Everyone should attend group photos even if you do not plan on ordering any pictures. The group picture is used for a display at the recital and for programs.

All dancers will be using the hair pieces that have been included with each costume. We have all hair pieces at the studio and will distribute them for pictures. Dancers will wear their hair piece on the left side of their head.


## Important Reminders

## **Attendance Policy Reminder**

Attendance is required for all classes.

<u>Please notify the studio if your dancer will be absent.</u> Acceptable absences listed below.

- After 2 classes have been missed consecutively or 3 classes have been missed in a semester, a private lesson is needed. If 4 or more classes are missed, your dancer will no longer be allowed to participate in the dance for the style being learned at that time. (Even if a private lesson was taken)
- Examples of acceptable absences: Illness, family vacation, family tragedy, important school graded events such as a concert or science fair. A two week notice is required for any family vacations or school graded event.





### **Dance Shoes**

All dance shoes need to be ordered through Revolution Dancewear for both picture day and the recital. <u>Dancers cannot wear a different brand of shoe.</u> If you need to order shoes, this needs to be done now.
